China records note marriage intentions with Elizabeth Day 13 Jan 1834. Other records call her Eliza.

1850 China census finds them next door to his brother Seth Jr, as residences 367 and 368. That and 1860, Weeks Mill cemetery inscriptions, and state vital records detail the family of 6 children. There may have

See Hallowsays of Taunton MA 1586-1949 p92/128-9/130. "Hiram ... died probably at Etna between 1847-50. No record of his children has been found, either at Windsor, China, or Etna, nor does anything appear regarding him in the probate registry of Penobscot Co. [The book presumed the first wife, unknown, had died, but we know her name and remarriage.]"

Windsor or China Vital Records microfilm shows intentions of Hiram and his brother Seth, one after the other:

"Mr Seth Hollowa of China and Miss Abigail Rollins of Augusta intend marriage Jany 1, 1828. Tho Burrill Clerk.

Mr Hiram Hollowa of China and Miss Joanna Day of Windsor intend marriage Jany 1, 1828. Tho Burrill Clerk." No divorce for Hiram found in Maine Divorces. China, Windsor and Augusta are all together in eastern Kennebec county.

1840 China census: Hiram Holloway 1 M 20-30, no family members. 4 other Holloways also listed (alphabetically by last name in town) - see father's listing. Some are brothers, some not sure.

1850 Etna census Lucinda and 3 ch w/o Hiram; liv next to Hiram's sister Ruth who md her cousin James. Lucinda and ch not found after 1850.

Page 129 also lists another potential child, Irena, age 17 in the 1850 China census, and Belfast records her marriage intention as Irene A Holway & Francis A Glidden, 12 Apr 1852.

Hiram married **Joanna DAY** on 1 Jan 1828. Joanna was born about 1811 in , , ME and died after 1850.

Joanna Day of Windsor md 1 Hiram Hallowell of China, int 1 Jan 1828; m2 Nathaniel French, Cert iss 6 June 1838 Belfast.

Belfast VR v2 p159: "Nathaniel French & Joanna Hollaway, int [rec between July 11 and Aug 15, 1835. Nathaniel French & Joanna Day, int Sept 20, 1837, Certificate issued June 6th 1838." Joanna's son John Hiram (Hiram J) married Nancy French, dau of Nathaniel's uncle Abraham.

Marston/Knight Ancestry tree says she d 18 Oct 1898 in Fryeburg; not found in Maine or NH death-recs. Hiram's brother John married Elizabeth/Eliza Day whose parents and grandparents are identified, and it is possible that they are sisters, though there is no record of Joanna's parents.

Belfast VR Deaths has 2 listings for Crissie. Both are buried in Grove Cem Belfast, Old Section Range 22 1/2. Christina Hallowell died of a tumor 11 Feb 1874 age 43 [Christianna Hollowell, dup Hallowell, CR3 Methodist Episcopal Church]. Grove Cem has Crissie, wife of Capt James H

Hallowell, d 11 Feb 1870 age 44.

Also buried there is second wife Jennie. Waldo Co Probate file #7939 says she d Feb 28 1903; heirs were her sisters, Mary Cook of Liberty & Hester A Leonard of Belfast. Her d/c confirms death-date, accidental drowning, age 79,0,15 born Winslow to Israel Smith b W & Hannah Raymond b Bowdoinham.

James married **Christina "Crissie" M BLAKE** on 30 Sep 1847 in Bangor, Penobscot, ME.

Christina was born on 6 Jan 1830 and died on 11 Feb 1874 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

James next married **Jennie A SMITH** in Dec 1874. Jennie was born on 13 Feb 1824 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME and died on 28 Feb 1903 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

- 37 F iii. **Abigail G HALLOWELL** was born in Mar 1829 in China, Kennebec, ME and died on 10 Nov 1906 in Jefferson, Lincoln, ME.

Abigail is placed in this family circumstantially; see Halloway Genealogy p92/130. "Note: The unidentified Abigail G Holloway who married James H Witham in Belfast on 25 Oct 1853, may also have been a daughter of Hiram by his first wife, as both his sons were living there at the time". [Likewise was their mother, Joanna Day Hallowell French.]

Her D/C as Witham does not list any parents, but the birth-rec of her last son gives her full name b China.

Abigail married **James H WITHAM**, son of **Joseph WITHAM** and **Eleanor JONES**, on 25 Oct 1853 in Belfast, Waldo, ME. James was born on 13 Jul 1823 in Washington, Knox, ME and died on 29 Mar 1901 in Jefferson, Lincoln, ME.

Hiram next married **Lucinda DURGIN**, daughter of **Solomon DURGIN** and **Martha BROOKS**, on 7 Dec 1843 in Etna, Penobscot, ME. Lucinda was born in 1822 and died after 1850.

An Ancestry tree says her parents were Solomon & Martha (Brooks), but also says she m1 in 1834.

Lucinda and James Brooks who md Hiram's sister were cousins acc to the chart by Kingman_2012-01-28 pkingman1. Solomon's ancestry is Joseph 1745 > Joseph 1715 > William 1670 > William 1643.

1870 Bangor census 985/1118: Joseph F St Clair 29 ME clerk in store, Emma 23 ME, Nancy St Clair 62 NH. Not found after that. 1880 Bangor census: Joseph F St Clair 39 ME-NH-NH clerk in store; Mary A 29 wife [??] ME-3. Nancy mother 71 NH-3.

1910 Bangor census: Joseph F St Clair 69, Mary A 57, M1 31y 0-0ch.

Maine Divorces: J Frank St Clair div Emma S St Clair/Hallowell in Jan 1878 Penobscot Co 51/102 docket 964.

Lydia married **Joseph Frank ST CLAIR**, son of **Benjamin F ST CLAIR** and **Nancy**, about 1865. Joseph was born in 1840 in Bangor, Penobscot, ME.

They fell in love despite the age difference and got married. Grace also said that he was an alcoholic (also proven in the divorce record of his first wife), and had blinding migraine headaches. A family story passed down is that she being still a girl and not knowing better, as a tidy person, she emptied the little bit of rat poison left over into an old aspirin bottle to make more room. During his headaches, Roland would blindly reach into the medicine cabinet and feel around for the aspirin bottle and mistakenly took the rat poison which killed him. Grace remarried three more times.
